Do you know???

- How many (private vehicles) would it take to transport students to and from school?

- How many times a year are school systems required by law to perform school bus evacuation drills and safe riding practices training?

- How many years and miles are required by the State of Maine Uniform School Bus Standards before a Type-C conventional school bus may be considered for replacement?
